

BADSHOT LEA LAWN TENNIS CLUB

Administration for 2018/19

1. MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Club is open to all (subject to the Constitution of the Club) and shall be limited to a maximum of 60 adult members.

The Club has been affiliated to the LTA since October 1st 2003. The club is also registered as a CASC (Community Amateur Sports Club).

2. FINANCE

The Financial Year shall end on the 31st January 2019 and an audited Statement of Accounts shall be published at the Annual General Meeting.

3. SUBSCRIPTIONS

Membership of the Club is by yearly subscription to cover the period from 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019. The categories of membership and subscription rates are as follows.

ADULT MEMBER

Annual subscription is £75 and is payable on the 1st April. Existing members who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £70.

SENIOR CITIZEN (over 60 on 1st April)

Annual subscription is £60 and is payable on the 1st April. Existing members who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £55.

STUDENT MEMBER (over the age of 18 attending full time at school or college of further education)
Annual subscription is £45. Existing members who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £40.

FAMILY MEMBER (the family membership covers two adults and their children under eighteen in the family)

Annual subscription for a family is £140 for new members and £130 for existing members who renew their subscription by 30th April.

PARENT & CHILD/CHILDREN (children under the age of 18 years on 1st April; fees:- parent same as junior fee and junior fee for each child)

Annual subscription is:

One parent & one child	£46
One parent & two children	£69
One parent & three children	£92

Parents are reminded that:

1. The nominated parent can only use the courts with their child.
2. The child can play with other junior members.
3. Should the parent wish to play other than with their child then they should pay a visitors fee up to a maximum of 4 times in a year.
4. Junior access to clubhouse only with parent present.

JUNIOR MEMBER (under the age of 18 years on 1st April)

Annual subscription is £23. Junior Members are able to play at all times except when the courts are required for club matches, tournament matches, club sessions, or other sessions prebooked by adult members.

Note that new members joining after the 1st August shall pay a reduced subscription of 50%.

4. VISITORS

Members may bring friends to play at the club. No visitor may attend more than four times per year on this basis. The name of the visitor and the host member shall be entered in the visitors' book at the time of playing and a fee of £3 per visitor shall be paid to the Treasurer by the club member bringing the visitor.

5. LEAGUE MATCHES

The Committee is entering one Mixed team in the summer 2018 leagues run by ADLTA. The selection of the team, together with the appointment of team captain shall be the responsibility of the Selection Committee which will be appointed by the Committee from all club members. All members representing the club in league or friendly matches will pay a match fee of £2 each per match (except juniors and students who will pay £1). 6. CLUB TOURNAMENT

Ladies singles, Ladies doubles, Men's singles, Men's doubles and Mixed doubles tournament events will be organised by the Committee. Entry fees for these events will be £2.50 per player per event. Finals' day is 9th September. A Junior Singles Handicap Tournament is planned for the year for those under 18 on 1st April. The entry fee will be £1.50 per player.

7. CLUB SESSIONS

The club sessions for adult members will be held from 6pm on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (starting 5th April), and from 10am on Sunday mornings arranged by members. When other members are waiting, players on court should play doubles and must vacate the court after playing eight games. An appropriate means, supervised by any Committee members present, shall be used to ensure that all members present get a fair share of court time, where possible with suitably matched and varied opposition. Selected junior members may be invited to club sessions at the discretion of the Committee.

8. HIRE OF PUBLIC COURT

In agreement with Waverley BC the courts will be available for hire by non-members. Application should be made to the key holder (Gillian Hyman). The charge is £5 per hour for adult members and £2.50 for junior members.

9. EQUIPMENT AND PAVILION KEYS

It is the responsibility of the last member to leave the courts to ensure that the nets are lowered and that the equipment is safely locked up in the pavilion. Pavilion keys are issued to full members on acceptance into the club. Replacement keys shall be issued at a charge of £3.00. Pavilion keys shall not be issued to junior members.
