- Play Doubles matches when possible
- A total of four games to be played per match
- Short deuces to be played at 40-40. i.e. If the score gets to 40-40, the best of 3 points decides the game
- At the end of the match, check the score on the other court. If it is nearing completion, then wait for them to finish and then mix the players up so everyone gets to play with and against different people.

Future Club Projects—update

The club's committee has been working to upgrade the facilities at the tennis club. The application for funding from the local new developments 'Community Infrastructure Levy' (CIL), has been successful and approved. The Committee is continuing to approach other funding bodies to help cover the shortfall. If all grant applications are successful, they will allow the installation of LED floodlights on both courts and a smart replacement ability-friendly clubhouse. Additionally the area around the new clubhouse will be paved and bicycle stands installed. An outside electrical point and water tap will also be provided. Despite chasing and prompting we are still awaiting notification of the final planning permission.

Plans for the new clubhouse and location of the floodlights are on display in the clubhouse.

2021 LTA Wimbledon Ballot—change in the process

All members are encouraged to belong to LTA as an Advantage Play+ member and affiliate to the Badshot Lea Tennis Club. This will give you free entry to the Wimbledon Ballot and many more exclusive venues and offers.



All LTA Advantage Play+ members received an email at beginning of June inviting to register for the ticket sale.

LTA have changed the way the Wimbledon Ballot will be run for The Championships. The changes that are being made are to improve the processes for operating the ballot, with a fair and transparent centralised process replacing the previously decentralised approach.

The changes to ballot processes are only applicable to LTA registered venues and LTA members linked to a club/venue for which going forward one centralised ballot will be held. In the new centralised system, clubs will not receive an individual allocation of tickets.

Note: There will not be a public ballot for the Championships in 2021.
