Club Landscaping Project

To complete the new look for the Tennis Club, a landscaping project has been launched. This is to improve the area surrounding the Clubhouse making the surface weed resistance and even. The Club has the backing of the Landlord, WBC, with provisos.

Farnham Town Council grant and the Postcode Lottery—Magic Little Grants will allow some substantial improvement, but not those originally planned. The committee have chosen to pro-

gress with basic improvements—dependent on WBC acceptance. The cost of materials and labour make it prohibitive to do anything grand. The clubs reserves need to be grown over next few years in readiness for resurfacing of the courts—estimated to be 2027.

We are fortunate to have an excellent ball machine at the club. Have you used it yet? It can give you a variety of ball deliveries to help improve your returns. The pre-season check-up found lots of balls jammed inside. If that starts happening again, please report it to the committee for repair. There is an instruction sheet in the clubhouse.



To help the longevity of the tennis balls we also have a ball pressuriser. Again there is an instruction sheet in the clubhouse.

Please try and use this after you have used the ball machine. Contact Gillian if you wish to have a walk through on how to use it.







Both ball machines now have a remote control, so you can start and stop them from other end of court!

[To enable it: turn on the "Remote Control" switch, then press the A button on the fob to enable/disable bAll feed, or C for the osCillator].
