

# **BADSHOT LEA LAWN TENNIS CLUB**

## **Administration for 2026/27**

### **1. MEMBERSHIP**

Membership of the Club is open to all (subject to the Constitution of the Club) and shall be limited to a total of 120 members.

The Club has been affiliated to the LTA since October 1<sup>st</sup> 2003. The club is also registered as a CASC (Community Amateur Sports Club).

### **2. FINANCE**

The Financial Year shall end on the 31st January 2027 and an audited Statement of Accounts shall be published at the Annual General Meeting.

### **3. SUBSCRIPTIONS**

Membership of the Club is by yearly subscription to cover the period from 1st April 2026 to 31st March 2027. The categories of membership and subscription rates are as follows.

#### **ADULT MEMBER**

Annual subscription is £100 for new members. For existing members, the fee payable on the 1st April is £100, but those who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £95.

#### **SENIOR CITIZEN (over 60 on 1st April)**

Annual subscription is £90 for new members. For existing members, the fee payable on the 1st April is £90, but those who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £85.

#### **STUDENT MEMBER (over the age of 18 attending full time at school or college)**

Annual subscription is £75 for new members. For existing members, the fee payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> April is £75, but those who renew their subscription by the 30th April pay a reduced subscription of £70.

#### **FAMILY MEMBER (the family membership covers two adults and their children under eighteen in the family)**

Annual subscription for a family is £190 for new members. For existing members, the fee payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> April is £190, but those who renew their subscription by the 30<sup>th</sup> April pay a reduced subscription of £180.

#### **JUNIOR(S)&PARENT/GUARDIAN (children under the age of 18 years on 1st April;**

fees:- parent same as junior fee and junior fee for each child)

Annual subscription is:

One junior & one parent/guardian	£70. Pay by end April	£65
Two juniors & one parent/guardian	£95. Pay by end April	£90
Three juniors & one parent/guardian	£120. Pay by end April	£115

Parents/guardians are reminded that:

1. The nominated parent/guardian can only use the courts with their child.
2. The child can play with other junior members.
3. Should the parent/guardian wish to play other than with their child then they should pay a visitor fee.
4. Juniors can only access the clubhouse when the parent/guardian is present.

#### **JUNIOR MEMBER (under the age of 18 years on 1st April)**

Annual subscription is £45. Pay by end April £40. Junior Members are able to play at all times except when the courts are required for club matches, tournament matches, club sessions, or other sessions prebooked by adult members.

Juniors can only access the clubhouse when an adult member is present.

Note: that new members joining any of the above categories after the 1st August shall pay a 50% reduced subscription until the end of March.

**MATCH PLAYER MEMBERSHIP** is to allow members of other local clubs who may not have the opportunity to play league matches with that club to join BLTC match players. The match player must be a full member of their main club, they will not have voting rights at the BLTC AGM.

£6 BLTC association fee to be paid to the Club bank account at each league match the player plays in. Match player form to be completed at first match.

#### **4. VISITORS**

Members may bring friends to play at the club. The name of the visitor and the host member shall be entered in the attendance record at the time of playing and a fee of **£4.00** per visitor shall be paid to the Club bank account by the club member bringing the visitor.

#### **5. LEAGUE MATCHES**

The Committee is entering Two men teams, three mixed teams and one ladies team in the summer and winter leagues run by the ADLTA. 4 players in each team. The selection of the team, together with the appointment of team captain shall be the responsibility of the Selection Committee which will be appointed by the Committee from all club members. All members representing the club in league or friendly matches will pay a match fee of **£3** each per match (except juniors and students who will pay £1.50). #### **6. CLUB TOURNAMENT**

Traditional Ladies singles, Ladies doubles, Men's singles, Men's doubles and Mixed doubles tournament events may be organised by the Committee. Entry fees for these events will be £3 per player per event. For a Swiss Tournament the fees will be £5. The Committee reserves the right on tournament format. Tournament days tbd. A Junior Singles Handicap Tournament is planned tbd for those under 18 on 1<sup>st</sup> April. The entry fee will be £2 per player.

#### **7. CLUB SESSIONS**

The club sessions for adult members will be held from 6pm Thursday evenings, and from 10:00am on Saturday mornings. When other members are waiting, players on court should play doubles and must vacate the court after playing four games. An appropriate means, supervised by any Committee members present, shall be used to ensure that all members present get a fair share of court time, where possible with suitably matched and varied opposition. Selected junior members may be invited to club sessions at the discretion of the Committee.

#### **8. COURT BOOKING**

The Committee reserve the right to cancel any excessive court bookings to ensure fair access to the courts for all club members.

#### **9. HIRE OF PUBLIC COURT**

In agreement with Waverley BC the courts will be available for hire by non-members. Application should be made to the Chairman. The charge is £5 per hour for adult members and £2.50 for junior members.

#### **10. FLOODLIGHTING**

The floodlights are available for members to use at a rate of £6/hour. Tokens will be provided on payment into the club bank account and application to Gillian Hyman. Full floodlighting management details are displayed in the Clubhouse.

#### **11. EQUIPMENT AND PAVILION ACCESS**

It is the responsibility of the last member to leave the courts to ensure that the nets are lowered and that the equipment is safely locked up in the pavilion. Pavilion entry code is issued to full members on acceptance into the club. Pavilion entry code shall not be issued to junior members.
